We have re-introduced some of the activities for the wider benefits of our community. As decided at the last AGM, Women's Forum was formed, and Malayalam classes re-launched to cater for the increased demand from our community. We have also strengthened our elder's service with the support of many new sponsors.

2018 was also the year that saw the worst natural calamity in the history of Kerala and have shook the conscience of Malayalees across the world. In the UK, MAUK was at the forefront of coordinating support for the relief efforts. Our members and well-wishers donated generously towards MAUK fundraising appeal. We have raised in the region of £40,000, the highest amount raised by any single Malayalee organisation in the UK. I have pride in informing you that our first project in Kerala; water treatment plant in Monkombu, a remote village in Kuttanadu is now operational and is serving purified drinking for seventy plus families. We are continuing with similar projects in various part of Kerala.

I take this opportunity to thank all our volunteers, well-wishers, sponsors and media partners who have contributed to the success of MAUK in 2018 and look forward to your continued support.

I welcome you all to participate in this AGM and provide your invaluable ideas and suggestions which will strengthen our Association.
